

English

In English, this term we will be covering a variety of genres including: Shakespeare, Current Affairs and Poetry. Within these genres, we will be focussing heavily on the grammar aspects to make sure that the children are confident in using different sentence types, word types and punctuation. The children will be given opportunities to apply these English skills within the other subjects such as: Science, History and Geography. We will also be unpicking the spelling patterns that are necessary for Year 5 and 6 and applying those to our work.

Art

Our art will focus on the work of David Hockney this term; in particular his landscapes. Children will use his techniques to create their own Hockney inspired landscapes.

Geography

This term, the children will further develop their use of atlases and maps to identify key rivers and mountain ranges of the world. They will identify the main features of both rivers and mountains.

History

Our topic of study in history this term is Crime and Punishment. Within this, the children will compare modern day crime and punishment with those from the past. They will explore and talk about the legacy of past methods of crime prevention and detection with those of the present day.

Physical Education

The PE foci in Class 4 this term are tennis, rounders and athletics.

Maths

In Maths this term, we are focussing on the following areas: Statistics, describing pattern, proportion, time, Roman numerals and measures

We will continue to develop the children's understanding and reasoning skills, enabling them to solve problems and identify if answers are reasonable.

Science

In Science, the children will be covering the areas of 'Life Cycles' and 'Human Health'. Within these topics, they will develop their observational, investigative and experimental skills to find out about life cycles of different animals and plants and also what things are necessary to remain healthy .

Design and Technology

Our DT will focus on the safe and hygienic preparation of food. The children will be learning how burgers are made and will taste different breads to enable them to design their own burger

Computing

The will be learning about 'Staying Connected' for computing this term. Within this topic, the children will be discuss the different technologies available which help us stay connected. They will explore the importance of remaining safe online and what to do if they are concerned about anything they see or hear whilst using technology.

Religious Education

In RE, pupils will discover what makes something sacred in religious terms and how this relates to them. They will also learn about ethics – developing their sense of what is right/wrong- just and fair.

Music

All the learning is focused around one song: Dancing in the Street As well as learning how to sing, play, improvise and compose with this song, the children will listen and appraise other pop songs.

PSHCE

In PSHCE this term, we will be covering aspects of Growing up including the physical and emotional changes children go through as they reach puberty.
