Sports Premium is funding given to schools to improve the quality of the PE and sport activities they offer their pupils. Schools must spend the funding to improve the quality of the PE and sport activities they offer their pupils, but they are free to choose the best way of using the money.

For example, we can use our funding to:

- employ a sports apprentice to work with teachers;
- provide existing staff with teaching resources to help them teach PE and sport;
- run a range of sporting clubs;
- run sport competitions or increase pupils' participation in sport;
- run sports activities with other schools.

Sports apprentice to support teachers in enhancing the teaching of PE and sport	£4000	- Children have more structured support within PE lessons due to the adult:child ratio being higher as well as out-of-school competitions - More opportunities for pupils to participate in lunchtime and afterschool clubs
Membership to sporting associations	£956	- Wider opportunities for children to take part in sporting events - Increased opportunity to engage with other schools in sporting activities and competitions - Training opportunities for school staff - Wider opportunities for pupils with additional needs - Opportunities for the PE lead to collaborate with other schools and engage in continued professional development
Enrichment Opportunities	£1396	- Targeted provision for individuals and groups pupils - Workshops include Hula Hoops, Skip2Bfit and KS1 School Games.
Afterschool Clubs	£702	- Opportunities for children to experience Lacrosse
Staff Training	£225	- Development of staff in teaching PE and Sports - Enhanced orienteering lessons with cross-curricular links - Skills progression becoming more evident throughout PE lessons

Lunchtime Activities Provision	£325	- Development of physical skills through play - Wider opportunities for all pupils to enhance physical skills
