Maths

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Science - Earth and Space

The children will identify scientific evidence that has been used to support or refute ideas or arguments. They will describe the movement of the Earth, and other planets, relative to the Sun in the solar system.

Animals including humans

The children will build on knowledge and understanding of different systems within the body.

Geography - Exploring Eastern Europe

The children will learn about the countries of Europe and look in more detail at contrasting areas. They will find out about the landscape, climate and locations in each area.

Computing - 3D Modelling

The children will extend their drawing skills to create 3D models using the software SketchUp. They will use their mathematical skills to support them with this.

Design and Technology – Marbulous Structures

The children will evaluate marble structures and investigate techniques they can use to strengthen and reinforce their own structures. They will explore how to join and shape materials in order to produce their own marble run.

Art – Artist: Paul Nash - In Flanders's Fields

-The children will use skills in painting, drawing and sculpture to create work based on poem In Flanders's Fields. They will develop an understanding of how art and design reflect and shape our History.

History - World War II

The children will use our topic of World War II to develop their investigation and Evaluation skills. They will organise information chronologically and understand how past events have helped to shape the world we know today.

Physical Education - Football and Tag Rugby

The children will refine and consolidate their dribbling, passing and shooting skills. They will develop their gameplay, furthering their understanding of attacking and defending situations (especially where one team is outnumbered).



PSHCE - Being Me in My World

The children will develop their understanding of being a citizen and recognising their rights and responsibilities. They will explore how behaviour affects groups and understand democracy as having a voice and participating.

Celebrating Difference

The children will explore cultural differences and how they can cause conflict. They will learn to enjoy and respect other cultures.

Music

In music we will be using songs and musical games to develop our musicality and awareness of how music 'works'. We will also be composing our own class piece based around a given rhythm pattern.

French - Regular or Irregular Verbs

The children will learn that there are regular and irregular verbs in French. They will use their knowledge of what a pronoun is and how learn this affects the changes in verb endings.

World War II

Through the topic of World War II, the children will group and order unknown vocabulary to help decode French text. They will improve their listening and reading skills as a result of this.

Religious Education – Celebration (marriage)

The children will explore the concept of commitment and defines what is meant by it.

Christmas

The children will explore incarnation through the Christmas story.
