

English

Over the first term we are going to be using different books to focus on learning our different writing techniques. We will focus on reading with intonation and fluency, give impressions and describe a character as well as using our senses and adjectives to build description. We will begin to use a range of prepositions and conjunctions in our writing and explore how we can use clauses to expand our sentences. Throughout our English lessons, we will continue to use our phonics knowledge and build on this to support spelling.

DT

As it is the time of year for the Harvest festival, we will be completing our DT project of bread making. We will be making our own bread products, famous to the Harvest season.

Art

In art this term we will be looking at the artist 'Lowry' and his drawings of the streets in the North of England. We will develop our use of perspective techniques to recreate our own street drawings.

History

Our History topic throughout Autumn is 'Roman Britain'. We will be looking at the reasons the Romans invaded Britain, how easy it was for them to take over Britain and investigate if the invasion was a positive experience for those involved.

Physical Education

Football – pupils will learn to create, understand and apply basic attacking and defending skills within a mini-game.

Basketball – pupils will develop their passing, dribbling, shooting and marking skills and use them within mini-games.

Tennis – we will cover the rules of tennis, movement around the court and the creation of space whilst working in pairs and groups.

Dance – we will begin to understand the attributes of dance.

Maths

We will begin the term looking at number and place value with year 3 focusing on numbers in the hundreds and year 4 focussing on numbers in the thousands. We will then move on to look at methods for mental addition and mental subtraction. After half term we will go on to learn about multiplicative reasoning, fractions and finally, our topic of geometry.

Science

In Science we will learn about healthy bodies and our teeth. We will understand different food groups and the nutrients different foods provide us with. We will explore the different bones and muscles in our body before moving on to investigating the effects of tooth decay.

Geography

For Geography we will be exploring 'The Americas'. We will focus on the physical and human characteristics of North and South America. We will learn the eight points of a compass and begin to associate weather with landscape and environment.

Computing

In our topic of 'Accuracy counts' we will be learning the most effective way to search for suitable results whilst carrying on our e-safety understanding.

French

We will be recapping core vocabulary such as numbers, days of the week, how to greet each other, alongside learning different verbs and using the phrase 'Je peux...'. We will then move onto saying the date in French and asking each other when our birthday is.

RE

Our first RE topic focuses on Hinduism, looking at different aspects of the religion including their beliefs, holy book and festivals. After half term we will move onto explore how Christmas is celebrated across the main religions in the world.

Music

We will use our names to create a piece of music that is all our own. We will be continuing to use our voices and bodies to create music, both of our own making and our own interpretations of existing pieces.
