

English

We will start the term, with the book **Frog and the Stranger**, with a big focus on sentence structure and punctuation.

Narrative – We will learn the story of The Last Noo Noo.

Non-fiction – The children will learn about Sharks then write labels and lists.

Poetry – One Silver Speck.

Through these texts we will develop word knowledge, phonics reading skills and stamina, alongside a love of books and reading.

Maths

We will be building the children's skills, knowledge and mathematical language in a number of mathematical areas. The main foci are:

- Geometry
- Regrouping amounts
- Strategies for adding and taking away
- Doubling and halving
- Counting in multiples
- Multiplying and dividing

Science – Habitats and Plants

We will explore the features of different habitats and microhabitats in the local area, including the creatures that live there. The children will investigate how animals use their chosen habitat. After half term, the children will be investigating plants, including the difference between seeds and bulbs: and what plants need to grow.

Geography- Journeys

We will be investigating the Journeys. The focus of this topic is the journeys that our food takes to get to us. This includes developing our mapping skills, and looking at a the variety of farms we have in the different countries of The British Isles.

DT - Puppets

We will explore various puppets and learn the different ways that they move.

We will then make different types of puppets developing our joining skills with a focus on sewing.

Art - Sculpture

We will explore mixing colours and printing. We will investigate the painting style of Alma Thomas, and the sculptures of Yayoi Kusama. We will develop their 3D modelling skills as they manipulate and join clay to create a final piece.

History – Family History

We will learn about how people they know have had different experiences compared to us, with a focus on family life and how people did things in the past.

Physical Education

During the first half term, we will be further developing our teamwork, aiming, passing, shooting, controlling and dribbling skills through the game of netball. We will also start to develop the gymnastic skills of balancing, coordination and controlled movement.

After half term, we will move on to tag rugby, where we will develop hand-eye coordination alongside our teamwork and cooperation skills.

Finally, we will developing our movement, control, flexibility and core strength through learning hockey skills.

Computing

We will learn how to draw pictures, then add animations and sounds. We will also learn how to change fonts, then choose, select and edit our preferred images.

French

RE

Hinduism - We will learn the main features of The Hindu faith, exploring celebrations, customs and symbols.

Celebrations - Through looking at a number of religions and beliefs, we will learn about how Spring is celebrated by different cultures and communities.

Music

We are focusing on using our voices and bodies to respond musically; working on developing control and general musicality. We are doing this by learning new songs and revisiting old ones.

PSHE

In the topic Dreams and Goals, we will have the opportunity to discuss our ideas and thoughts about the near future. We will celebrate our achievements and challenges we have met.

After half term, we will learn about having a healthy life style and the value of good choices, through the topic, 'Healthy Me!'
